EUROPEAN AND AMERICAN ART. THIS IS HOW IT LOOKS LIKE.



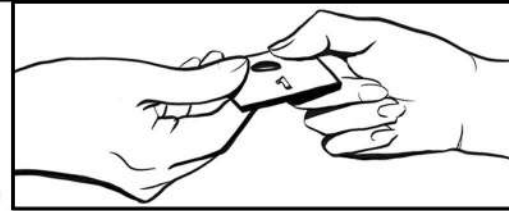
HERE IS THE ENTRANCE.

WAIT A FEW MINUTES FOR OUR TURN.



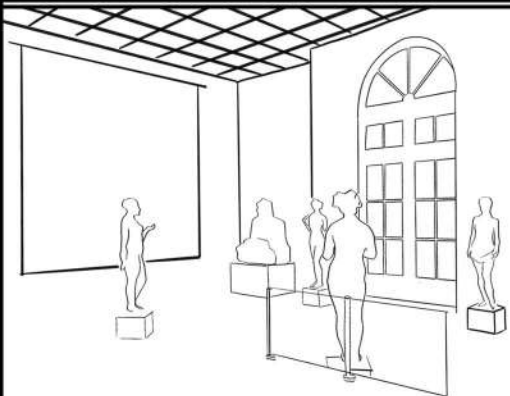
HERE WE CAN LEAVE OUR COATS OR

THEM IN A SPECIAL LOCKER AND TAKE THE KEY.



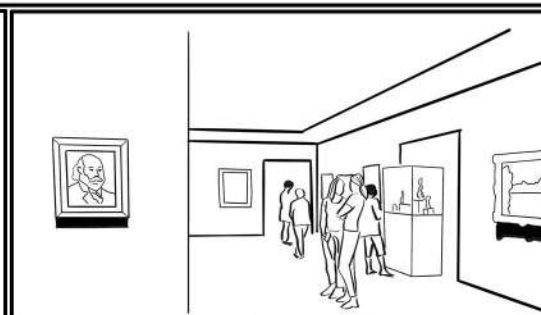
THERE IS A RESTROOM NEARBY.

HERE, IF WE NEED IT.



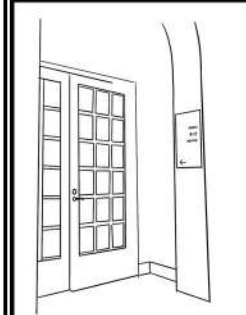
WE WILL GO UP THE STAIRS TO A HALL WITH A VERY HIGH CEILING.



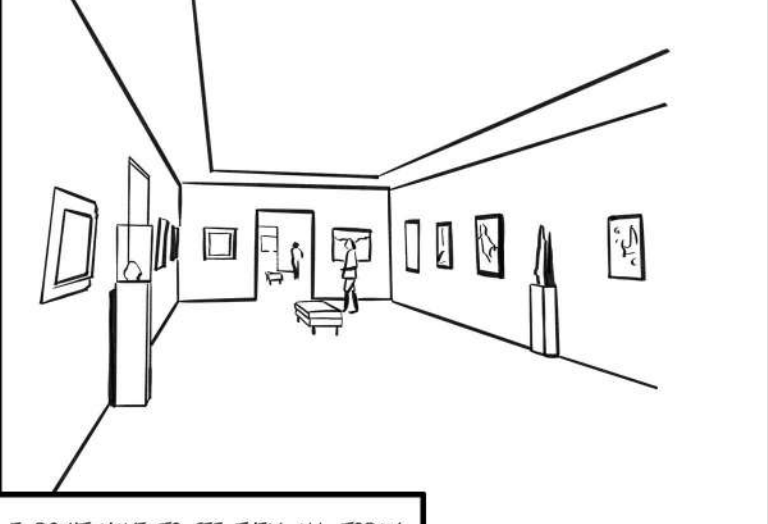
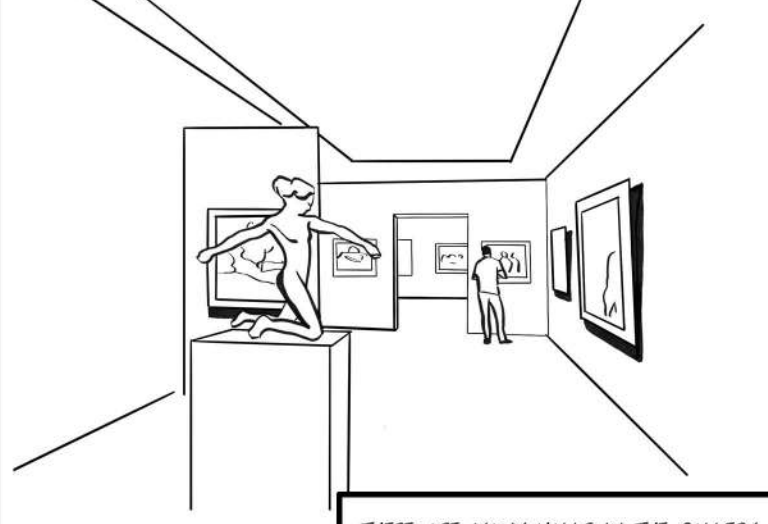
HERE WE WILL SHOW OUR TICKET TO

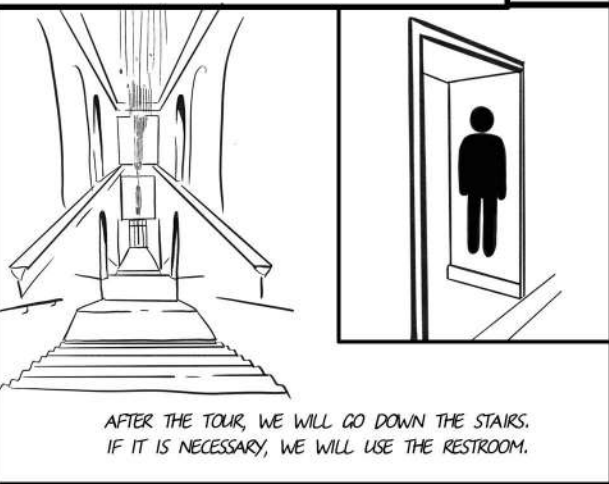


WE WILL SPEAK QUIETLY AND KEEP OUR DISTANCE FROM PAINTINGS AND SCULPTURES.

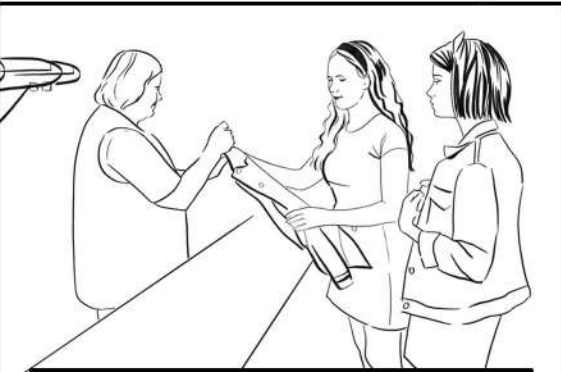
